

## Fair Rules and Regulations

1. The Association will put forth every effort to protect all exhibits but will not be responsible for any loss.
2. Watchmen will be provided by the Association where and when deemed necessary for the best interests of the exhibitors.
3. No exhibitor will be allowed more than one exhibit in any one class except livestock where as many entries as desired may be made.
4. Entries including livestock will be received on: Sunday, Sept. 3, 2017 from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
5. Entries close at 7 p.m. Sunday.
6. No exhibits in Home Show shall be removed before 8 p.m. Saturday, but all exhibits must be removed before 10 p.m. Saturday. Livestock may not be removed before 8 p.m. Saturday.
7. All premium tags must be left on the exhibits until the exhibits are removed.
8. Sawdust will be furnished by the Fair Association but each exhibitor is responsible for his own hay and grain and also for the feeding and watering of livestock.
9. No premiums will be paid for any exhibit not listed in the catalog. Entries will be made according to classification.
10. No premiums will be paid for exhibits by commercial concerns or made by individuals engaged in the commercial making of the exhibit.
11. The Fair Association shall not be responsible for any injury to either spectator or exhibitor.
12. The decision of the judges will be final.
13. All home economics entries must have been made or produced within twelve (12) months prior to this Fair date.
14. Every exhibit accepted for premiums must be given an Entry Tag which must be plainly marked showing the name of the exhibit.
15. Mailing address must be given by all exhibitors when receiving exhibitor's number. All youth exhibitors should be registered c/o parent or legal guardian. All premiums will be paid by check and mailed to the exhibitor.
16. It shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor to know proper name of article or breed of livestock they are exhibiting.
17. An entry fee for all animals must accompany the entry blank. Checks may be made payable to Spartansburg Fair Association & will not be refunded.
18. Vendors may not drive or park any vehicles on the midway until 12:30 a.m. Sunday. Stands may be disassembled, but paved and dirt aisle ways must remain clear until 12:30 a.m. on Sunday.
19. An exhibitor must have full independent control over their livestock entry to be permitted to enter any classes.
20. **No alcoholic beverages permitted on fairgrounds.**
21. **All entries must be pre-registered.**
22. **No pets permitted on fairgrounds.**
