2017 HOMEMADE CHOCOLATE CAKE CONTEST
SPONSORED BY: PA State Association of County Fair

RULES:

1. Participant must be an individual amateur baker who is a Pennsylvania resident. One entry per person.
2. **Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Homemade Chocolate Cake contest at any other fair in 2017.**
3. Entry must be a layered chocolate cake made from "scratch". Pre-made mixes are not acceptable ingredients.
4. Entry must be frosted and frosting must be made from "scratch".
5. Cake recipe must feature chocolate or cocoa as a main ingredient.
6. The entire cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard or other food safe disposable setting.
(All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
7. Recipes must be submitted with the entry, printed on one side of 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Recipe must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. *(All recipes and cakes will become the property of the Fair of PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)*
8. Refrigeration is not available at the fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.

9. Judging Criteria:

Flavor	30 points
<i>(aroma, taste, good balance of flavorings)</i>	
Texture	25 points
<i>(moist and tender crumb; not soggy or dry)</i>	
Inside Characteristics	20 points
<i>(even grain, evenly baked; free from air pockets)</i>	
Outside Characteristics	15 points
<i>(consistent shape/size/surface; overall appeal)</i>	
Frosting	10 points
<i>(taste, texture, even color)</i>	
Total	100 points

Annual Blue Ribbon Apple Pie Contest Rules

- Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident; one entry per person.
- Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest at any other fair in 2017.**
- Entry to be a pie that must include at least 60% apples in the filling. It does not need to be a "traditional" two crusted apple pie and it can have a variety of fillings.
- The entire pie must be submitted for judging in a disposable pie pan. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
- The recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with the entry. It should be submitted on one side of 8 1/2" by 11" paper. The recipe must list all the ingredients, quantities and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. (All recipes and pies will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- Refrigeration is not available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
- Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor	30 points
Filling: (consistency, doneness, moistness & flavor)	25 points
Crust: (color, flavor, texture, doneness)	20 points
Overall Appearance	15 points
Creativity	10 points
Total	100 points

NOTES:

- Creativity is essential to a varied competition. Do not limit your contest to a "traditional two-crust apple pie. We are looking for a variety of fillings in the pies; the pie must include at least 60% apples in the filling.
- The recipe for the pie and pie crust will also need to be submitted when entering at The PA Farm Show.
- Each fair must sign a Certification Form verifying the winning apple pie baker, and this person will be eligible to enter the state competition at the **2018 Farm Show**.

NOTE: If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2017 for this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2018 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.

Angel Food Cake Contest Rules

- Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident.
- Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Angel Food Cake contest at any other fair in 2017.**
- Entry must be an Angel Food Cake made from "scratch".
- Pennsylvania produced and packed eggs** are requested to be used if at all possible. Please look for the PEQAP or PA Preferred logo or PA packaging dates on the carton.
- Refrigeration is **NOT** available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after the judging for food safety reasons.
- The entire Cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
- Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (printed on one-side of 8 1/2" x 11" size paper). Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back of the page. (All recipes and cakes will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor (smell, taste, flavoring)	30 points
Inside Characteristics (texture & lightness)	25 points
Overall Appearance (surface, size, color)	20 points
Creativity	15 points
Topping, Icing or Decoration	10 points

1. Canned foods to be judged on quality, general appearance, and container.
2. Use standard mason-type, clear quart/pint glass jars for preserving and exhibiting fruits, vegetables, and meats.
3. Use two-piece self-sealing lids (flat disc and metal screw bands) for sealing all jars of food.
4. All food not in standard jars or not sealed with self-sealing lids will be disqualified by the judge
