RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All contestants must pay regular gate admission.
2. No alcoholic beverages permitted on fairground.
3. A tractor can only pull once in a class. Each tractor can only pull in two classes.
4. Lawn stock tractors must remain completely stock. No governor attachments such as cables or wires that would make it inoperable are permitted. Governors on lawn stock tractors will be checked for a 3800 R.P.M. maximum, with a tachometer.
5. Stock tractor RPM limited to 4200. Modified and Stock Altered, unlimited.
6. Tractor must have a hood and fenders.
7. No implement, except for mower deck, can be used as weight.
8. Only two-wheel drive tractors allowed. No tire chains, metal lugs, or dual wheels allowed.
9. Fixed frame mounts drawbars only. No hydraulic or 3-point hitch.
10. All classes must have a tractor type seat with a back, and seat must stay in a fixed position during the pull. Driver must remain in the seat, but not on the seat back, with one hand (no finger tipping) on the wheel and both feet must remain straddling the tractor.
11. Loss of any weight or equipment on tractor will disqualify it.
12. Tires: Lawn 23X10.5 X 12 Maximum, turf or bar; Modified and Stock Altered 12X12X26 Maximum, turf or bar, may be cut; stock 23X10.5X12 maximum, turf or bar, uncut.
13. Stock, Modified and Stock Altered tractors must have vertical exhaust and a kill switch.
14. Stock, Modified and Stock altered tractors must have wheelie bars that are not less than 5 inches behind the tire and not more than 5 inches off the ground.
15. Stock altered tractors are permitted to have electric fuel pumps.
16. Hitch height: 10 inch maximum for lawn; 13 inch maximum for stock, modified and stock altered tractors.
17. All lawn stock tractors must have a workable mower deck.
18. If the track official senses a violation or failure to comply with these rules he may request the tractor in question to prove compliance to the rules. This may happen at any time.
19. Tractor, driver and helmet will be weighed prior to contest and immediately after the pull.
20. All drivers must have helmet, long pants and shoes.
21. Driver must stop the tractor immediately upon signal of judge. Judge's decision is final.
22. The Spartansburg Fair Association will not be responsible for accidents.

1. Open to tractors 1960 and older.
2. Weights of the bolt-on type. Must be securely fastened to the manufacturer intended position. No weight brackets. No suitcase weights. Any lost parts shall be grounds for disqualification.
3. All tractors will be in stock condition as they came from the factory with no pulling enhancing modifications. Stock block and naturally aspirated (exception: tractors originally equipped from the factory with GM two-stroke diesel engines). Stock head, manifold, carburetor, and air cleaner. Replacement manifolds are to be replacement manufacturer parts accepted for that make and model tractor. Stock engine RPM. Engine parts not in parts book for that specific tractor cannot be used.
4. No racing or aviation gasoline octane booster permitted. Tractors must dynamometer on the fuel used during the pull.
5. All tires are to be no larger or smaller than one size over or under factory original, no cut tires, radial tires or chains.
6. Tractors will pull from factory original draw bar as measured at top of draw bar or at pull point stationary in all directions, with a 17" maximum height and minimum 22" length from the center of the axle (6,500 lb. class and under). 20" maximum height and 25" minimum length (7,000 lb. class and over).
7. Factory clevis or shackle may be used, straight or twisted type with a minimum 2 1/2" hole bolted or pinned tightly with spacer to draw bar. Pull plate material will be allowed; material can not be thinner than 3/4" and not thicker than 1 1/4". Plate must have a 2 1/2" hole with a 1 inch material thickness around the hole. The drawbar must remain inside the opening of the clevis. Any tractor pulling from the NON fixed draw bar (ie: draft control, 3-pt. hitch or 2-pt hitch). "Must secure the hitch in a locked position." All tractors without stationary hitches will pull Exhibition Only. TOP OF HITCH ADJUSTER CAN NOT BE ABOVE CENTER LINE OF AXLE OR HUB. Except for factory mounts. (This wording added as per safety committee-7-30-03)
8. All tractors will be checked by a tech crew and could be subject to dynamometer and tachometer testing. All decisions of the tech crew and/or safety committee are final.
9. Track Officials will stop the pull at any time they feel the tractor or driver is unsafe and/or the front wheels have exceeded a height of 16".
10. No shifting of gears during pull (including torque amplifiers).
11. Minimum age of driver is 16. Tech Crew will determine if the driver is capable. Driver cannot be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Driver must remain seated. Driver must weigh tractor in. Tractor may be subject to be reweighed after pull.
12. Participants can be disqualified for being discourteous to other participants or to officials.
13. Participants will have three (3) minutes to get tractor to the line upon notice of class line-up; or the line-up committee can disqualify them.
14. Appearance — only parts in the parts book for that model of tractor are allowed. Seats must be stock seat or a replacement seat with stock mountings. Replacement alternators or straight exhaust pipes are allowed. Stock side shields allowed if factory equipped. Tractor and wheel weights will be to an acceptable width, not to exceed 8'6".

3. All vehicles must have brakes
4. All participants must meet the qualifications of the class: examples: "female" - both driver and rider "15 and over" - both rider and driver.
5. Any participant who hits the incoming/outgoing gate with their ATV will be disqualified from that event.
6. Flag Race - all (3) flags must be in the buckets to receive a time.
7. Please look at all class qualifications before entering (especially the classes that are listed by bike size).
8. If you are not sure of the course pattern (ex: T-Barrels), check at the registration booth. Maps of the patterns are available.
