

#### **WOOL DISPLAY**

Wool exhibited must be produced by the exhibitor who owned the sheep from which the fleece was shorn. Exhibits are open to both Purebred and Commercial Flocks. Only two (2) exhibits per person per class except special class of six (6) fleece.
