Eligibility

Exhibitors must show at BOTH Spring & Fall (Fair show) to be eligible for the High Point Award.

High Point riders must sign up for the High Point award by the end of the show

You can only sign up for one high point division per horse/rider combo.

Each horse/rider combo must show under the same number BOTH shows.

Exhibitor must have the class sheet marked according to their division sign up, so that their points may be properly scored.

Division age groups are different then showing age groups

Points Guidelines

For classes of 5 or less:

First place shall be awarded a point value equal to the number of exhibitors entering in the class.
(exhibitors must enter the ring-'Scratches' are not counted.)

Example: in a class of 4 horses, 1st place = 4 points, 2nd place = 3 points, 3rd place = 2 points and 4th place = 1 point.

For classes of 6 or more:

First place will be awarded 5 points plus a 'participation' point will be awarded to all exhibitors entering the class.

Example; in a class of 10 horses, 1st place = 6 points, 2nd place = 5 points, 3rd place = 4 points, 4th place = 3 points, 5th place = 2 points, and the remaining five entries will each receive 1 point.
